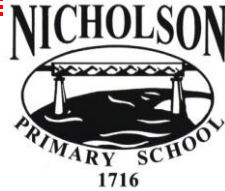

With the weather warming up and summer fast approaching it is a good time to remind everyone that our school is listed on the Education Department's Bushfire At-Risk register (BARR). This means it has been decided should an Extreme Fire danger Rating day be forecast or a Code Red day be determined by the Emergency Management Commissioner for our area, our school will close for that day. The school will contact you directly via SMS message before the end of the prior school day.

I acknowledge that potential closure of our school on a forecast Extreme FDR day may result in some inconvenience to you and your family, but the safety of our students and staff remains our top priority. As part of preparing our school for potential hazards such as fire, we are in the process of updating and completing our Emergency Management Plan for the coming year.
